## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

The Cullman Electric Cooperative Scholarship is open to high school seniors who are a Cullman EC member (or a child or legal ward of a Cullman EC member) who has been in good standing for at least 12 consecutive months at the time of the application deadline — Friday, February 23, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. Only one scholarship can be awarded per family per year. Amount of scholarship is \$1,000.

A student can receive the Cullman EC scholarship only one time. It is not renewable. The scholarship monies will be awarded prior to the upcoming fall semester or quarter with the student's valid proof of enrollment as a full-time student at the accredited college, university, or technical school of his/her choice.

NOTE: THE VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE CULLMAN EC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM. DEPENDANTS OF CULLMAN EC BOARD MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

The scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

Transcript / GPA	35 pts.	Official transcripts only — must be signed by counselor
Activity List	35 pts.	Include honors/awards, community service and school activities as well as years of involvement and any position held for each.
Essay	15 pts.	In 200 words or less, describe your career goals and reason for choosing field or profession. Must be typed, double spaced, 12-point font.
Recommendation Letters (2)	15 pts.	One (1) from a teacher and one (1) from a community member (non-relative)

The application must be filled out <u>completely</u> and turned in to Cullman EC along with <u>official</u> transcripts, activity list, essay and recommendation letters by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 23, 2024.
